PUPIL PREMIUM


Cape Cornwall School, in line with all school's nationally, receives additional funding for some students e.g. if they have free school meals, called 'Pupil Premium' funding. This funded is for use by the school to improve student progress and details about how Cape Cornwall School uses this funding are available on our website.

In previous years, Cape Cornwall School allocated significant sums of pupil premium funding to uniform and to subsidising transport to the school for families outside of our catchment area. Our evaluation of the impact of using the funding for this suggests that it had very little impact on improving the progress, attendance or behaviour of students. Because of this, our use of pupil premium funding for these purposes has to change and we hope that parents will understand and support the use of this previous funding for activities and support which directly helps to improve education and student achievement. For September 2018, if your child is eligible for pupil premium funding then the school will provide a blazer to help families to manage the cost of school uniform. The school only provides a blazer at the start of Year 7 and the costs of lost or damaged blazers will not be covered by the school. No other uniform subsidies are available from pupil premium funding.

The school does have a small hardship fund which parents can apply for if there are exceptional financial difficulties. Please contact Ms Long or Mrs Crawley for a confidential conversation about this fund.
