Labour Market Information (LMI) provides statistics, research and analysis about current and future economic and job trends to inform and support career and business planning decisions.

Keeping up to date with what is happening in the labour market is important for anyone making careers related decisions about their future and LMI should play a key role in any careers decisions you may make.

You should be aware of:-

- What opportunities are out there
- What the future trends are likely to be in different sectors
- What qualifications and skills are required

Good quality Labour Market Information (LMI) can help a young person make career decisions and plan their future. In a rapidly changing local, UK and global jobs market young people can no longer solely rely upon the experiences and advice of their family and friends.

Labour Market Information in relation to careers generally includes information on general employment trends, data on what jobs exist, how many and in which sectors and job types, information on the demand for skill, the supply and where current and future skills gaps and shortages might exist and what job progression opportunities are available.

The [National Careers Service produce regional infographics](#) , which shows current employment trends, they do this every three months. These are easy to use resources with students.

The [Careerometer uses national LMI](#) data to provide information on how a specific job will grow. Students can compare up to three jobs.
