Uniform	Required Uniform	Unacceptable
Blazer *	Students must wear the school blazer (compulsory).	
Jumper	A school V-neck jumper is available and can be worn underneath the blazer (optional). Students can also wear a plain, navy blue, unbranded, V-neck jumper under their blazer (optional).	Cardigans, crew neck or alternative neck jumpers are not acceptable. Hoodies are not acceptable.
Trousers	Students may wear plain black trousers or knee-length shorts. These must be of a formal/ tailored style that holds a crease. Belts, if worn, must be plain black.	Jeans, leggings, chinos, joggers or other informal styles of trousers or shorts are not acceptable. Visible logos or brand names are not permitted. Baggy shorts, board shorts or casual styles are not allowed.
Skirt	Smart, pleated navy blue skirt of an appropriate length (at least 20"), worn at knee level with no splits. The school has a standard skirt available from our suppliers or parents can purchase the skirt from an outlet of their choice, providing it matches the description above.	Tight or stretchy skirts, skirts with splits, informal styles; in short, styles other than the school skirt described opposite, are not acceptable.
Shirt	Plain white, long or short sleeved with a collar. Worn tucked in.	Informal styles of shirt or those with logos are not permitted.
Tie *	Clip on school tie, in the school colours.	Other colours or styles of tie are not permitted.
Shoes	Plain black shoes or plain black canvas/ trainer style school shoes with black laces (where required). The shoe must cover the foot and be secure when worn.	No visible logos or markings of any colour are allowed. High heels and boots are not appropriate. Strappy or loose styles or flip flops are not allowed.
Socks/ tights	Plain black socks without logos or markings or black tights (at least 40 denier).	
PE Kit *	The school rugby shirt, skort or shorts, and school PE socks are required. * Students may wear a base layer of a plain colour under their PE kit. This is optional.	

PE Footwear	Trainers: must be suitable for indoor and outdoor use with a white, non- marking sole. In the Autumn and Spring terms, students will also need suitable footwear for football and rugby.	
Jewellery	A wristwatch, one pair of small stud earrings, and one small plain ring are allowed. No other jewellery or visible piercings are allowed.	'Smart' watches, bracelets, bangles, necklaces and other jewellery are not permitted. Facial, tongue and other body piercings are not allowed. Tattoos are not allowed.
Make Up	We prefer that students do not wear make up to school. If make up is worn, it must be discreet and natural in appearance.	Heavy make-up which is obvious and indiscreet is not allowed. Nail varnish and/or false nails are not allowed.
Hair Style	Hair must be smart and worn in a conventional style and should be a single, natural colour.	Dyed hair with colours outside the natural range is not acceptable, nor is hair of more than one colour. Extreme hair styles are not allowed. The definition of an extreme hairstyle is at the discretion of the Head of School.
Coats, hats, scarves	Coats, hats, scarves and other outdoor layers should not be worn inside the school building. Lockers are available for student use to store outside clothing.	
Condition	All uniform items must be clean and in good order. Ripped or dirty uniform is not acceptable.	

School clothing, equipment and bags must be free of words, symbols or images which are inappropriate for school. This includes references to political groups, offensive slogans, swear words or references to drugs or alcohol.

Items marked * (the school blazer and the school PE kit) **must** be purchased from our suppliers or second hand from the school.
