Students will be allowed to wear their own sports clothes for the whole week, apart from on Tuesday and Thursday where they will need to wear their Core PE top; where students wear their own clothes, they need to be appropriate clothing for the activity and the weather so please check the schedule. Students will need to prepare for all eventualities of weather by bringing sun cream, sunhat, coat and a bottle of water. The classroom for sports week will be M1, where students will register each morning. The teachers leading the sports week are Mr Gapp and Mrs Watkinson.

On Tuesday 2nd July, students will be leaving via coach to Taunton at 7:30am so students will need to arrive and register at 7:15pm. Students will return at 7:00pm. Students will have one stop on the way to Taunton. A small amount of spending money could be brought for snacks and gifts that they might want to purchase at the cricket ground. Students will be required to bring packed lunches on Tuesday and Thursday. If your child is eligible for free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided. The canteen will be open each day to students attending school. On Thursday, students will be walking to the golf club, leaving at 9:00am and returning for their usual transport home at 3pm.

All other days, students will be able to use the usual transport to arrive and return home. Monday, Wednesday and Friday sports week students will be at school and therefore able to use the canteen as usual.
