I am writing with the final information for our Year 7 Activities Week programme.

The classroom bases for 'Year 7' will be A1 and A2, where students will register each morning. Students will arrive at the usual school time and the school day will start at the usual time 8:35am. Students will be returning to school each day by 3pm to ensure students can return home using their usual transport.

Students will be allowed to wear their own clothes for the whole week - this needs to be appropriate clothing for the activity and the weather so please check the schedule carefully. Students will need to prepare for all possible weather conditions by bringing sun cream, sunhat, coat and a bottle of water. Students will be outside most days so appropriate clothing for the activity is essential.

On Tuesday, students will need to bring swimwear or wear their swimwear under their clothing with a spare change of clothes. At Jubilee Pool there will be adequate facilities for changing with boys and girls separated. Students should also bring a towel/towelling robe, a bottle of water and sunblock which is water proof. Students may bring their own wetsuit if they wish on Tuesday.

Students will be required to bring packed lunch on Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday. On Wednesday if your child is in group A, then a packed lunch is also required. If your child is eligible for free school meals, a packed lunch will be provided. The school canteen will be open all week for students who are attending school. If your child is eligible for free school meals, lunch will be provided.
